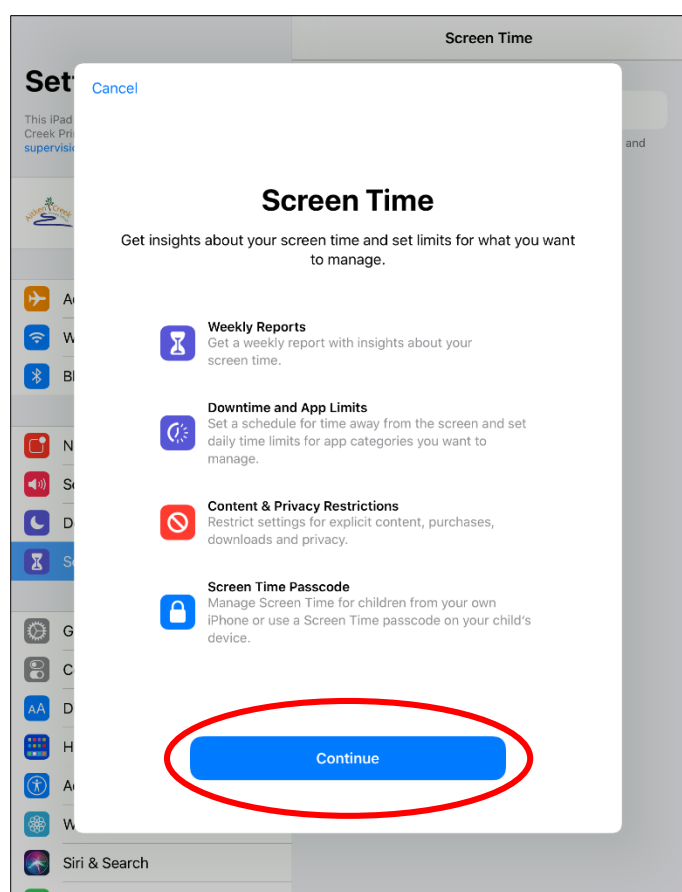

Screen Time

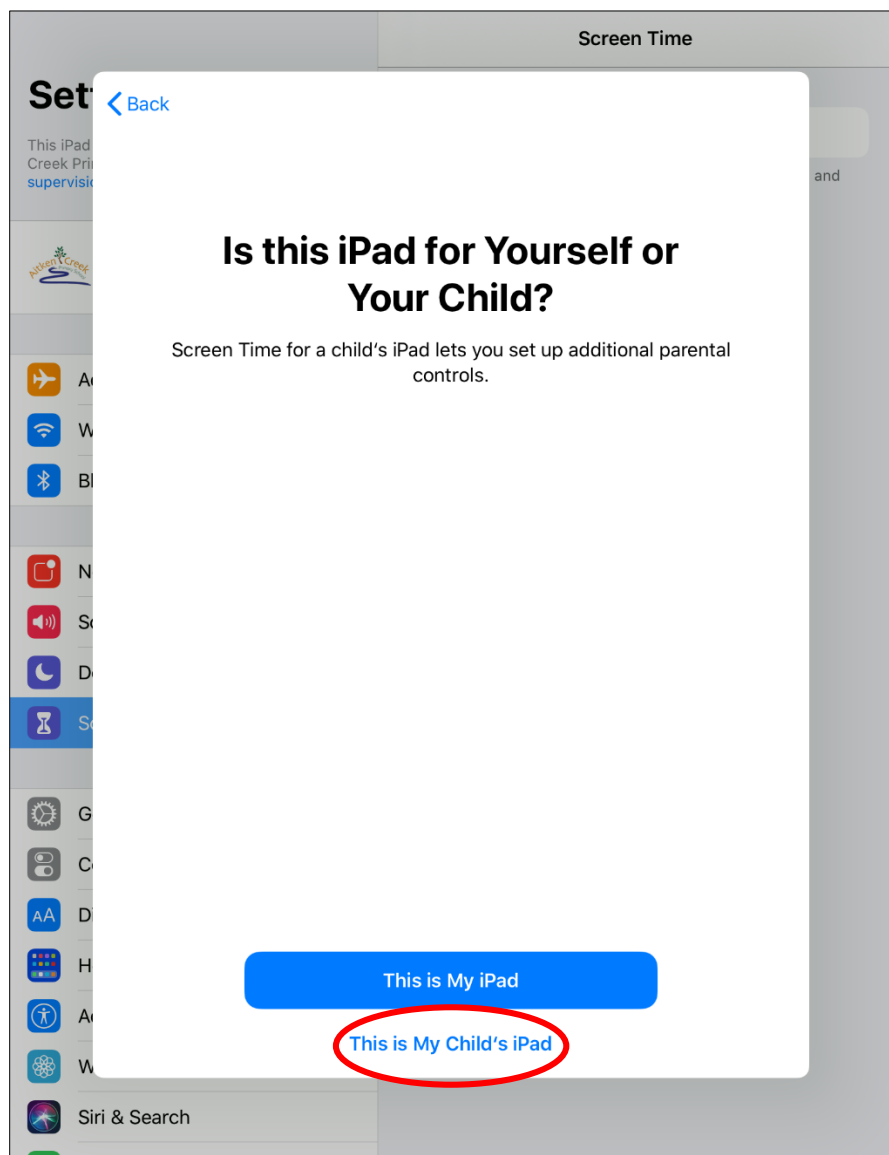
Turn on Screen Time

Get a weekly report with insights about your screen time and set time limits for apps you want to manage.

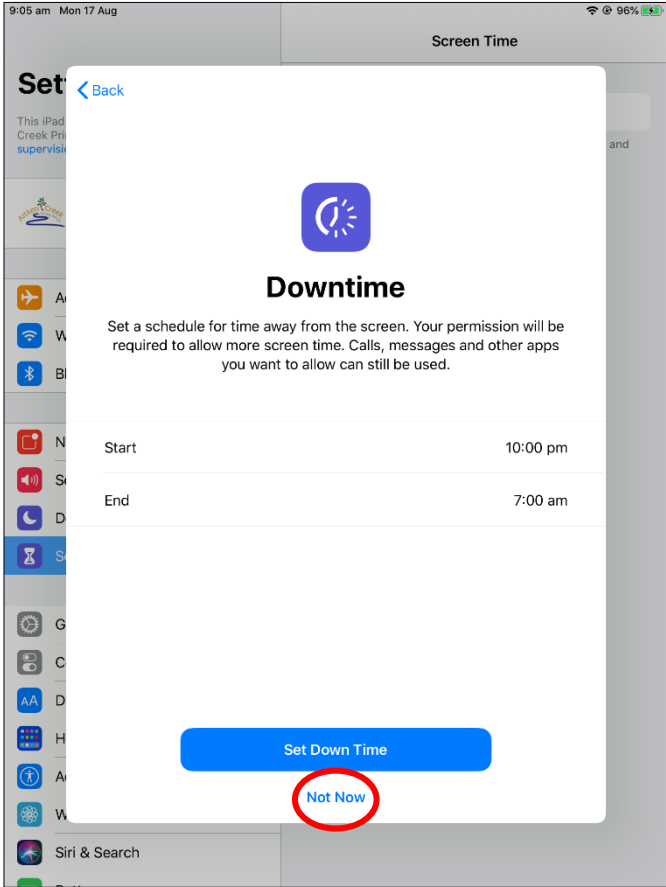
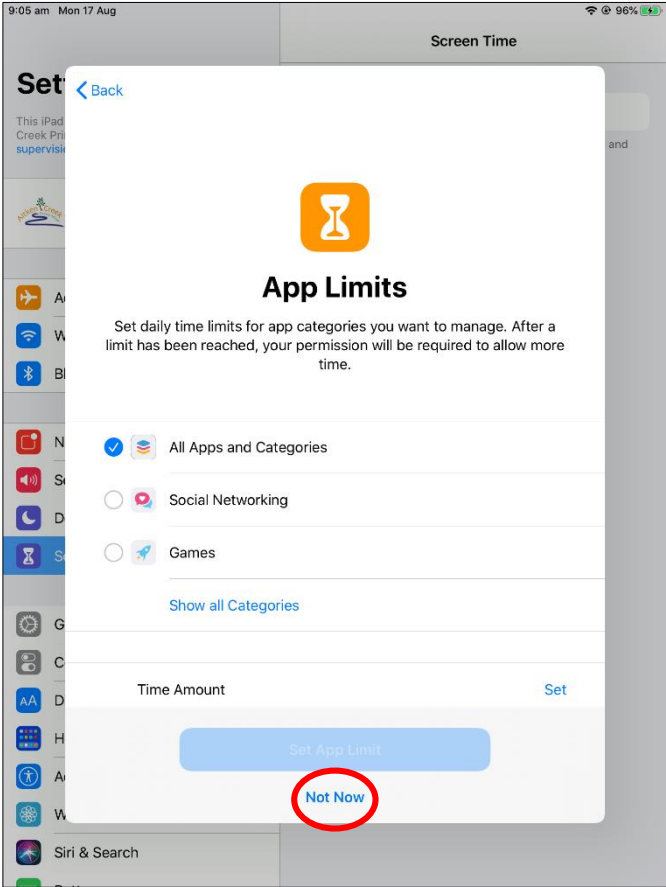
Tap on **'Continue'**



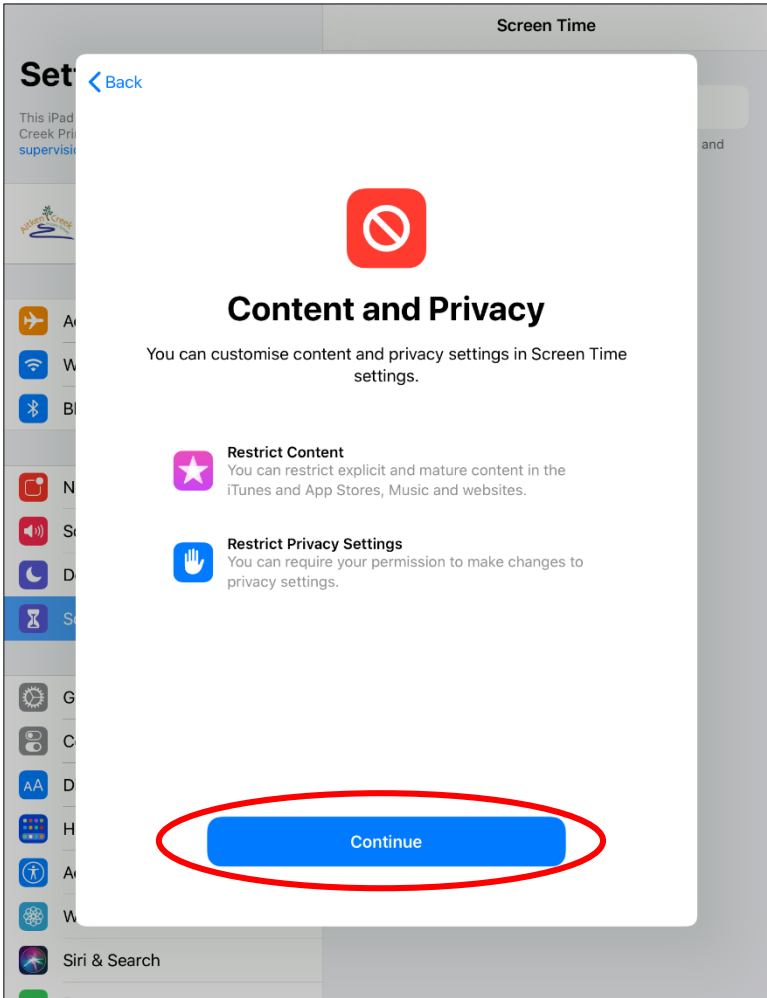
Then tap on **'This is My Child's iPad'**



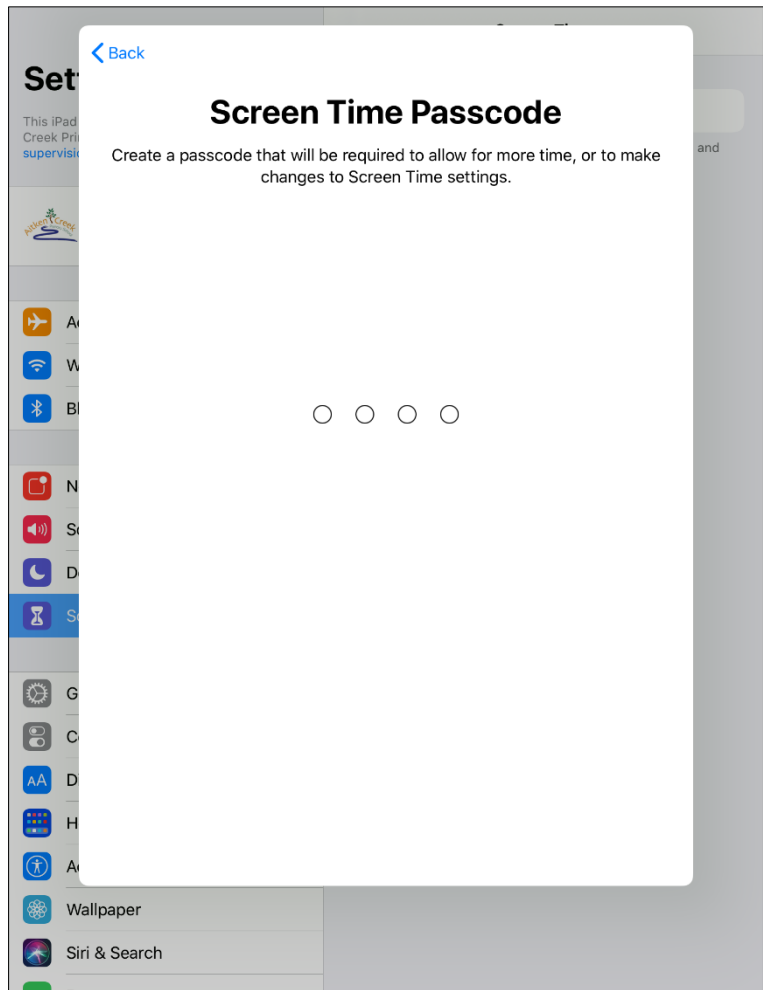
Tap on ‘Not Now’ for the next two steps



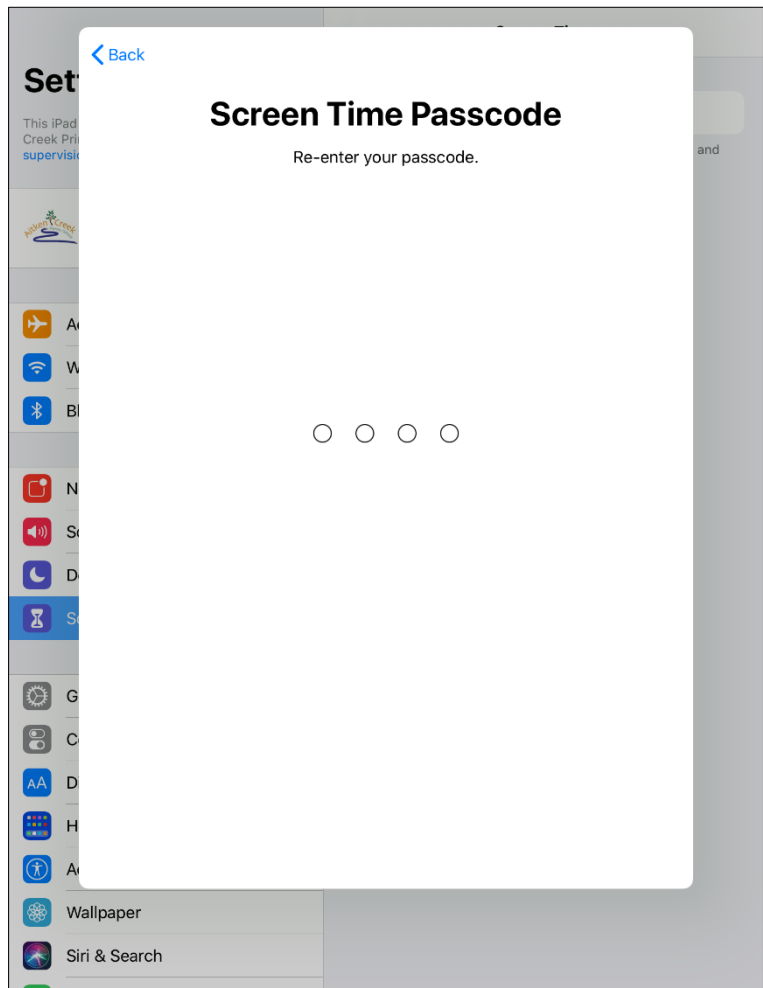
Then, tap on ‘Continue’



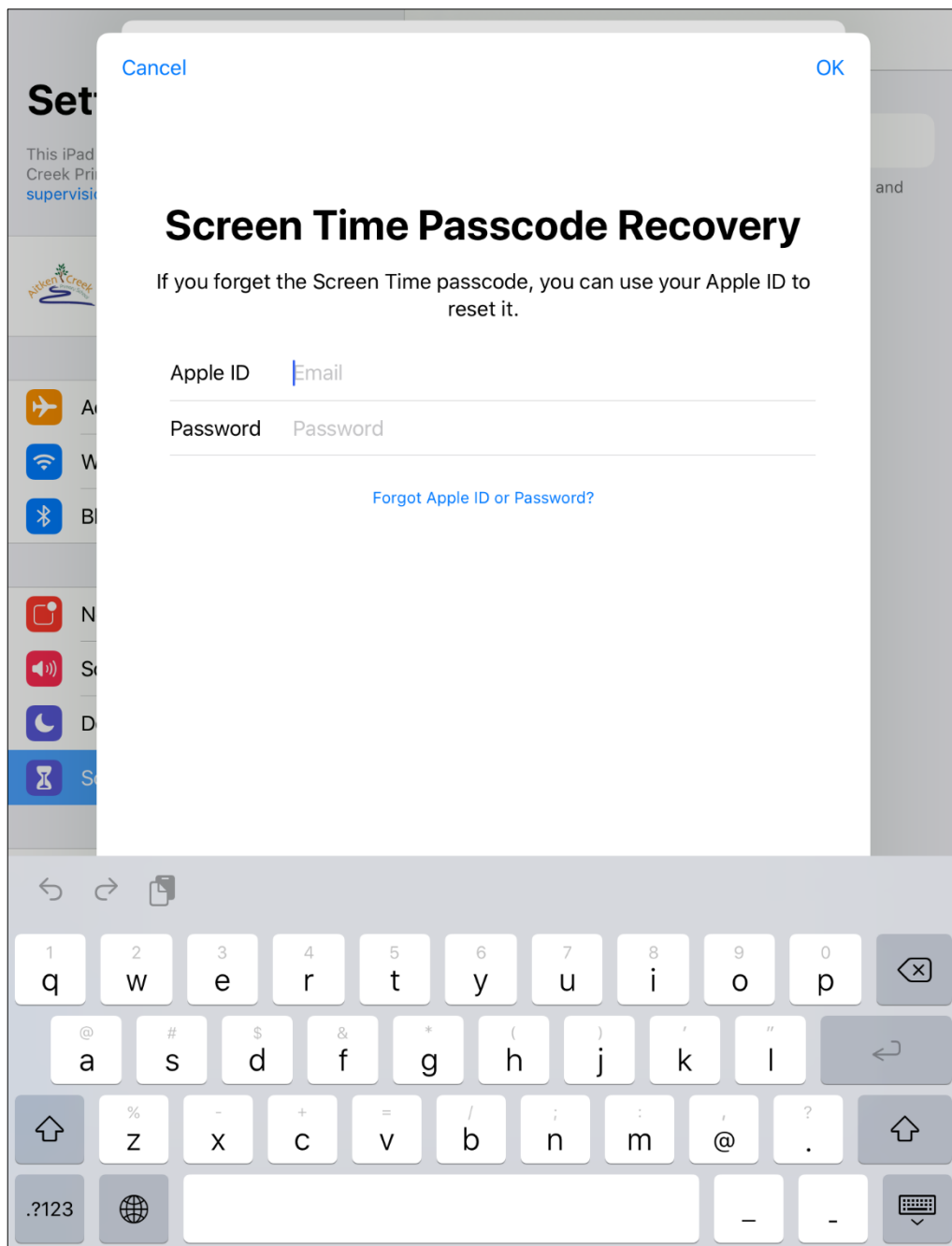
You will then be prompted to enter a Screen Time Passcode. Ensure the passcode is different to the passcode used to unlock your child's iPad.



Confirm the passcode you choose by typing it again.



You will then have to setup the Apple ID to use if resetting the Screen Time Passcode. The Apple ID you type must be different than the one that is logged in to your child's iPad.



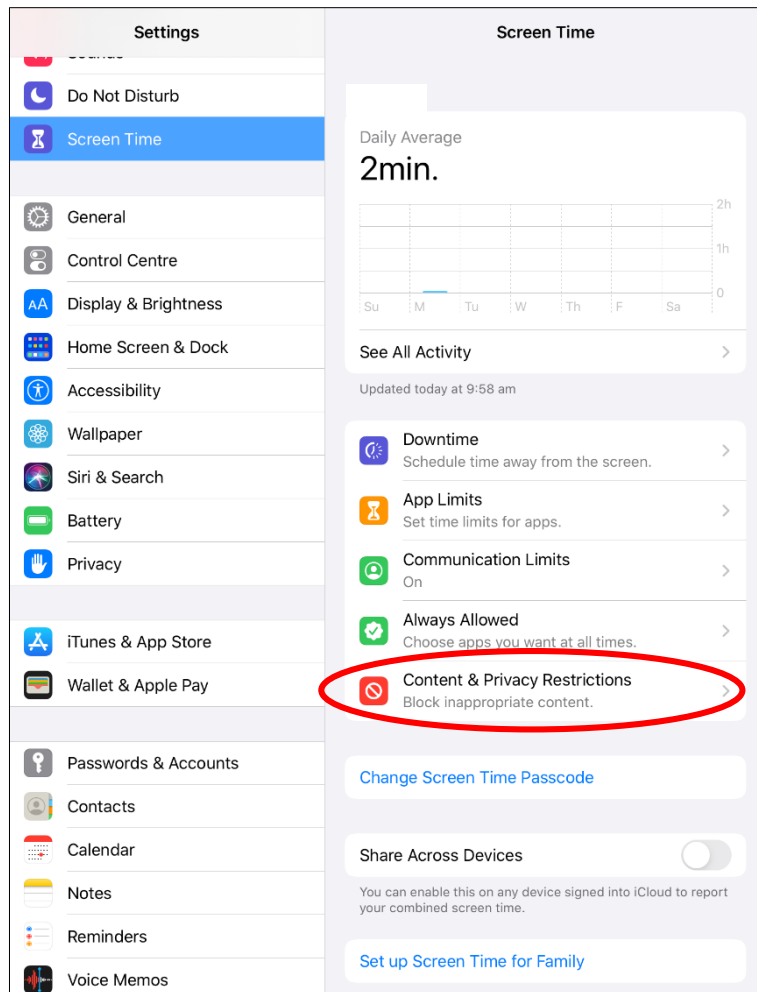

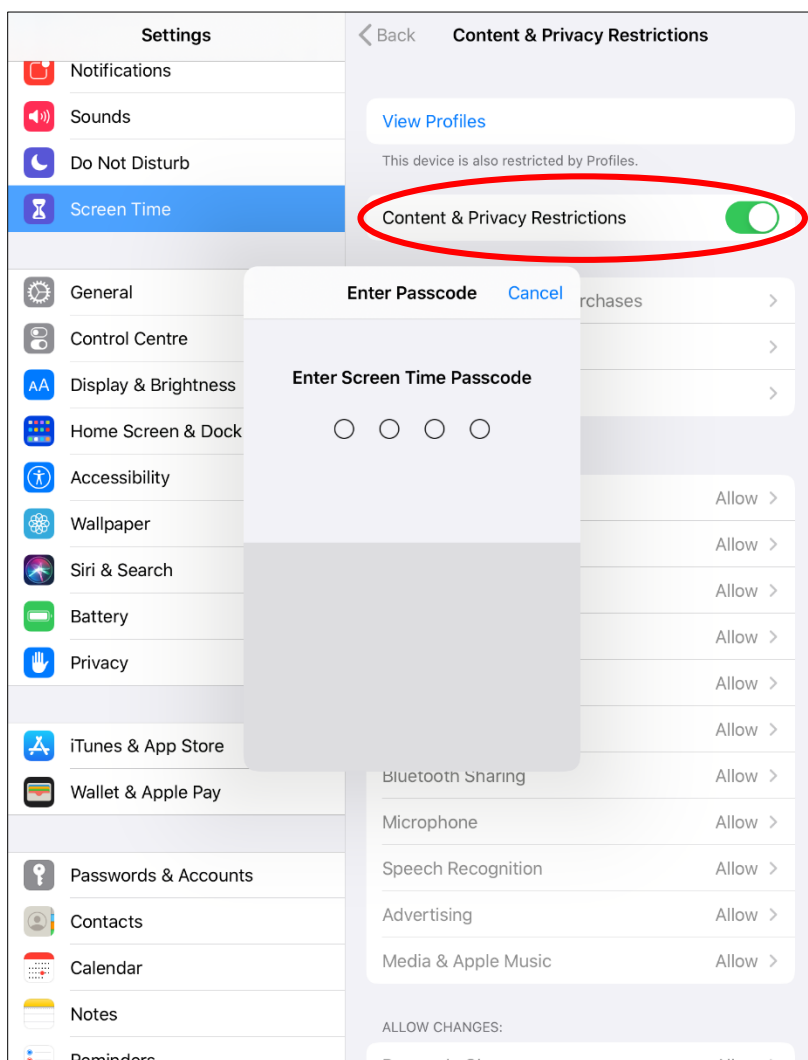

Tap on 'Content & Privacy Restrictions'

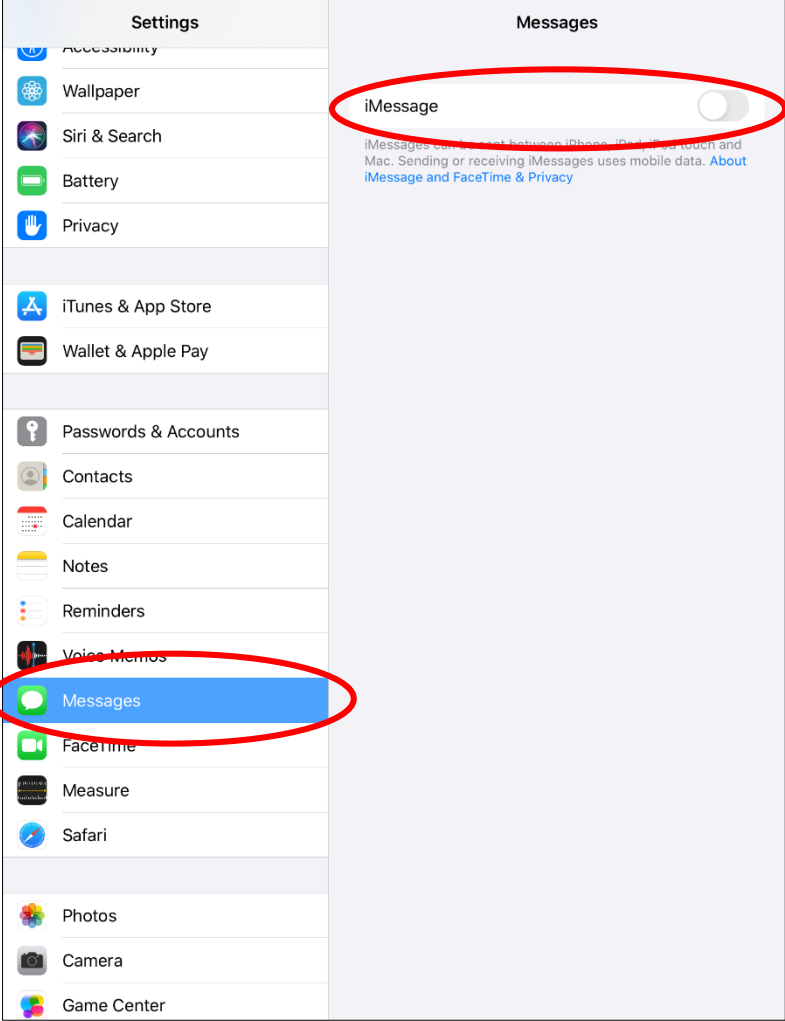


Then, turn 'Content & Privacy Restrictions' on by tapping on the grey circle until it turns green. Enter your passcode for confirmation.

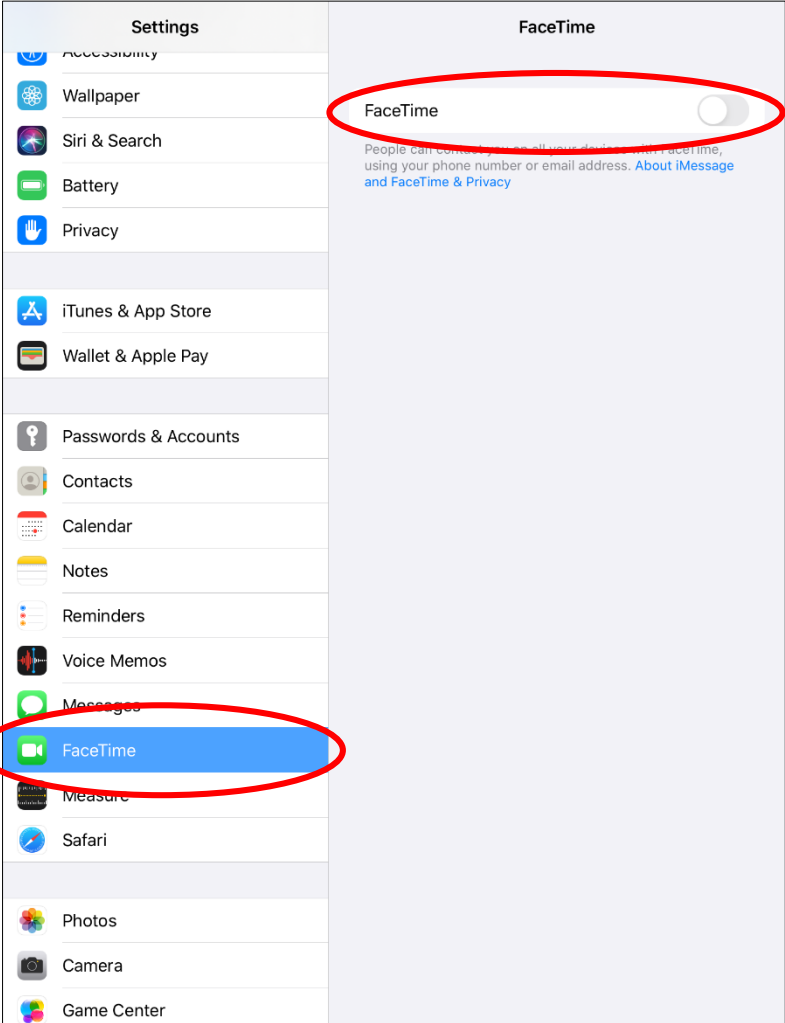


To restrict iMessage and FaceTime...

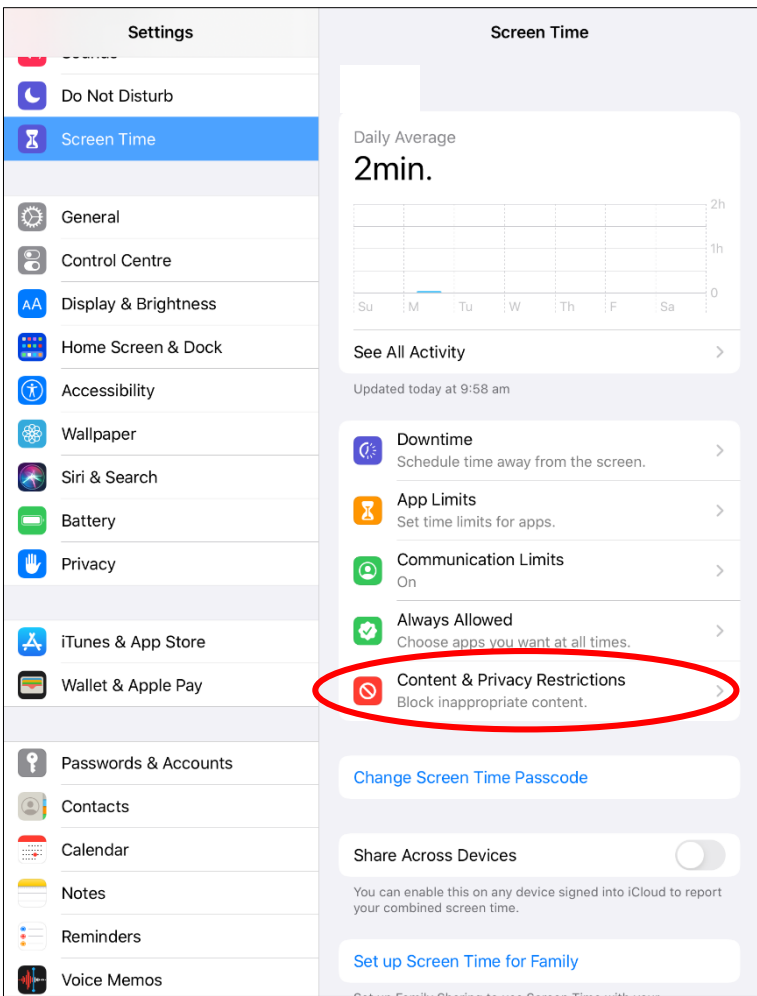
... scroll in the left sidebar downwards, tap on ‘Messages’, then turn off iMessage



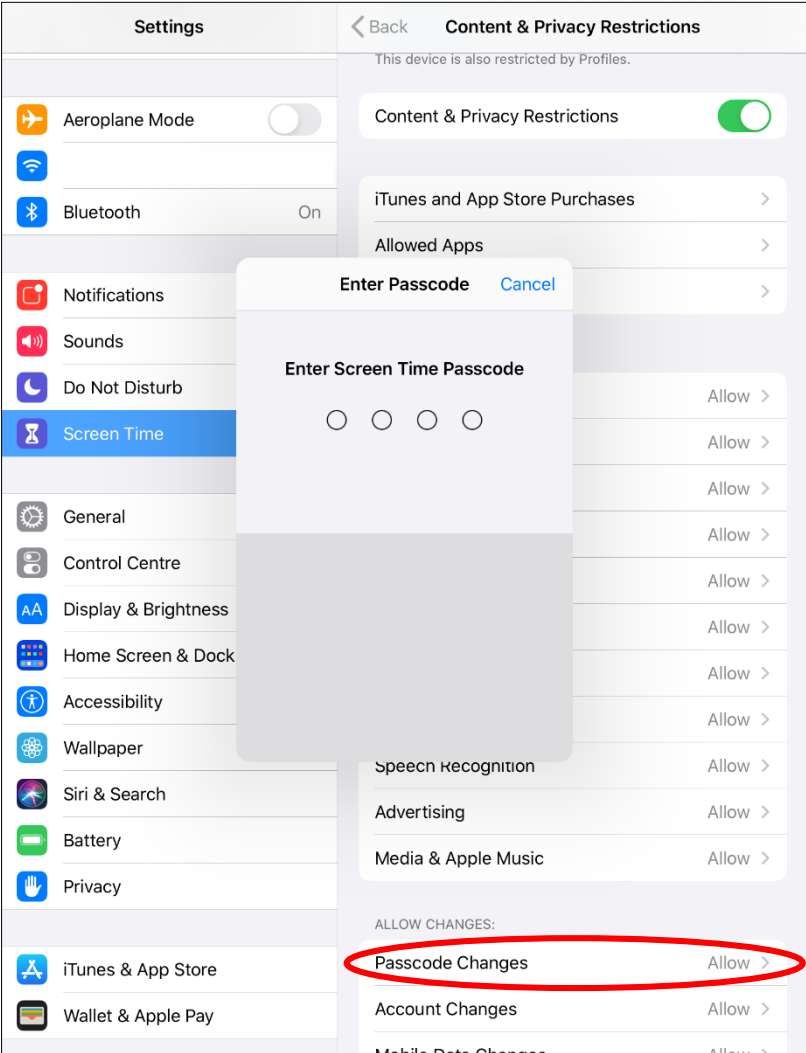
Do the same for FaceTime



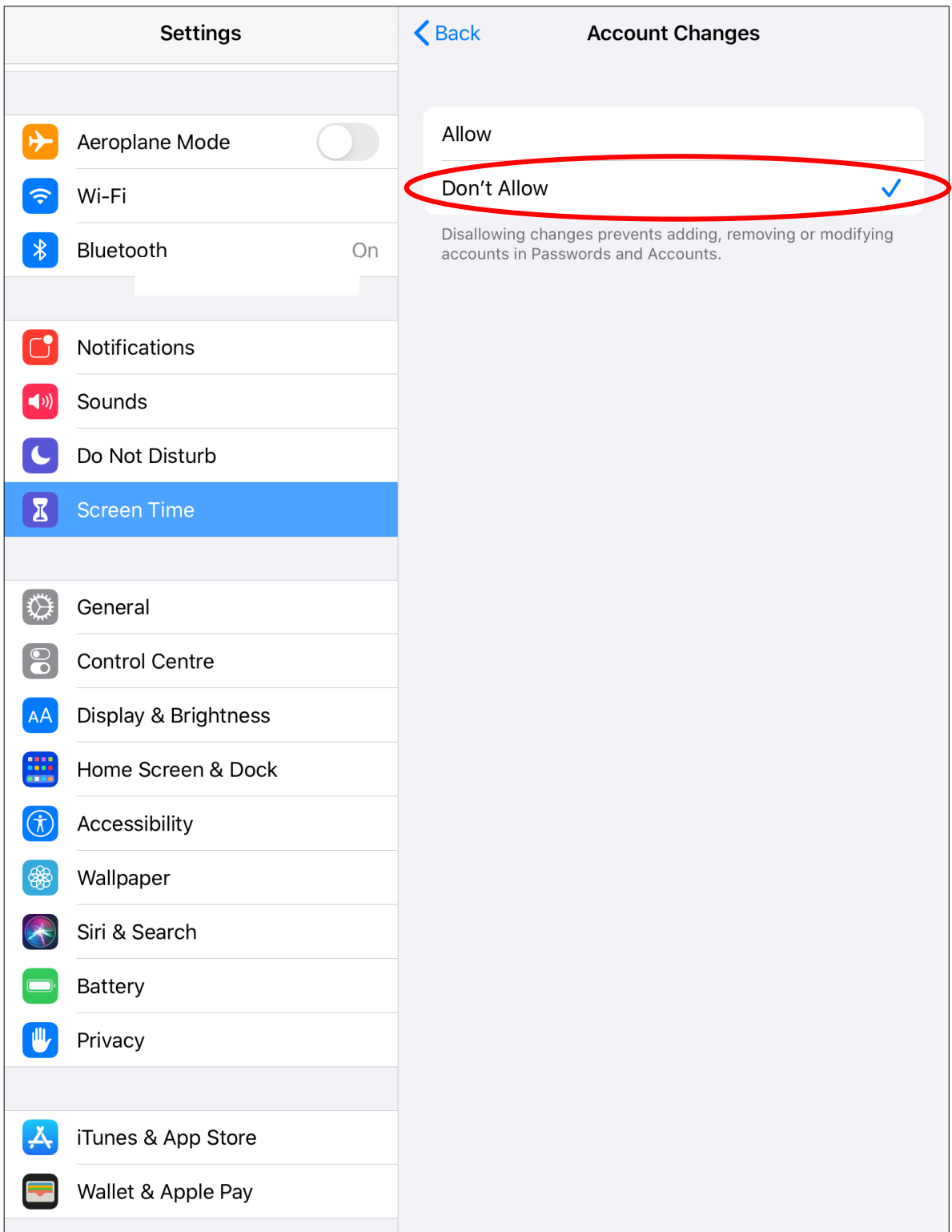
Go back to **‘Screen Time’**
and tap on **‘Content & Privacy Restrictions’**



Scroll down to **‘Passcode Changes’**, and then enter your passcode



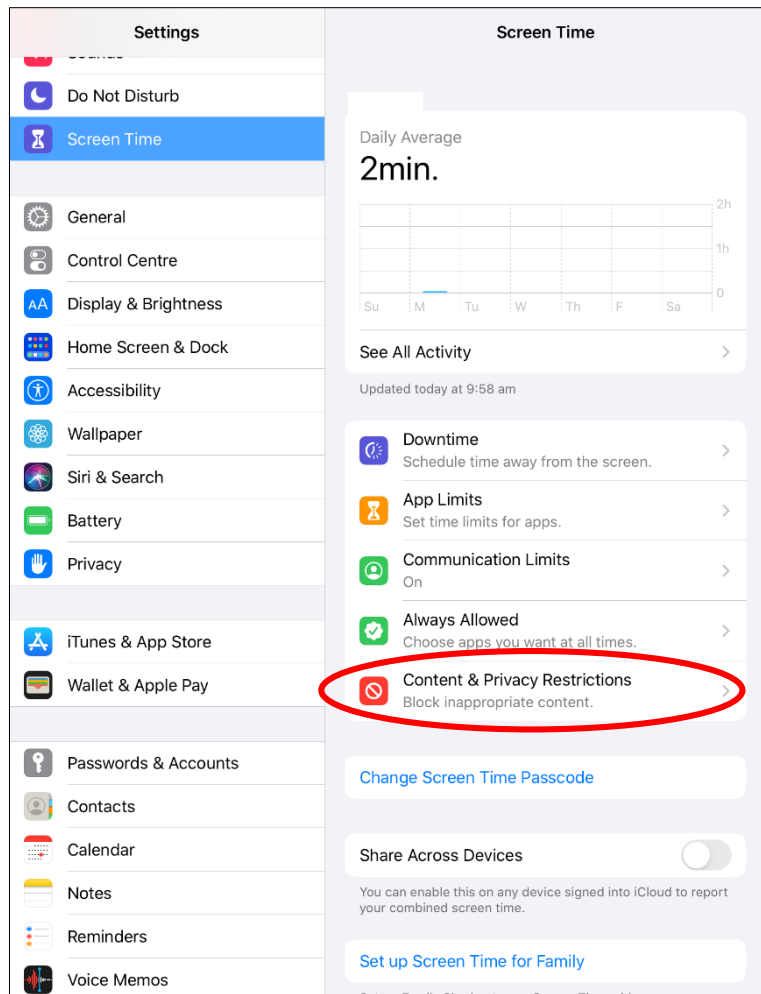
Tap on 'Don't Allow'



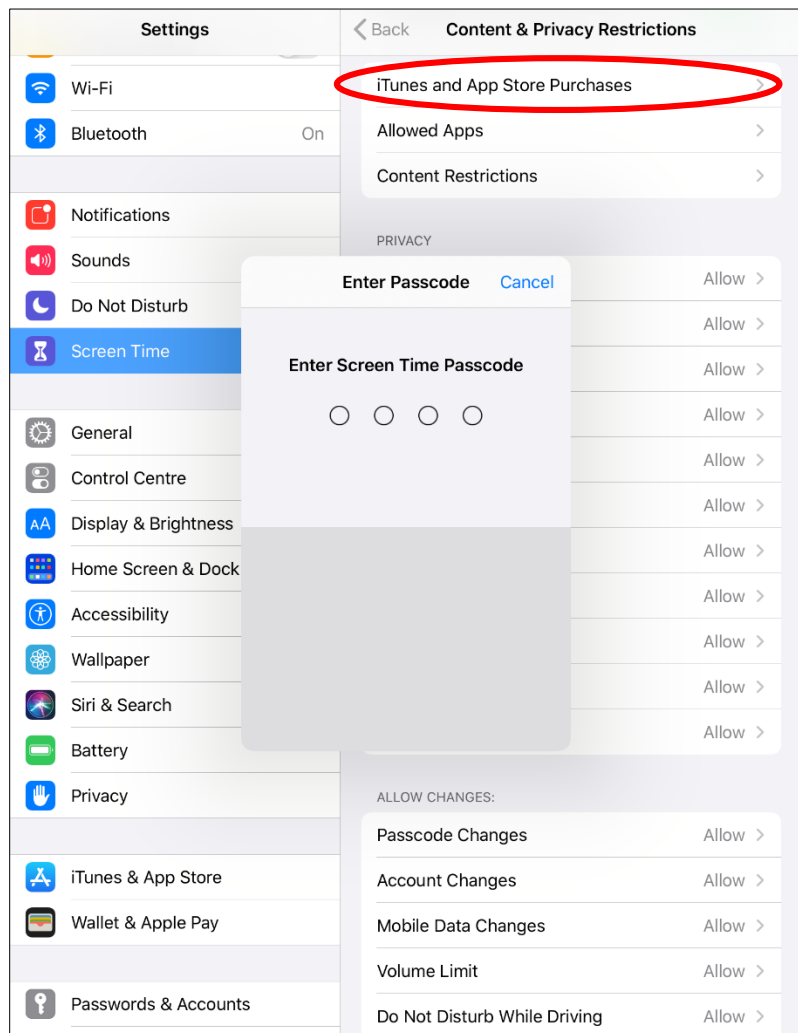
Messages and FaceTime will now be restricted. Your child won't be able to message or video call anyone. No one will be able to message or call your child's iPad too.

To restrict your child downloading apps...

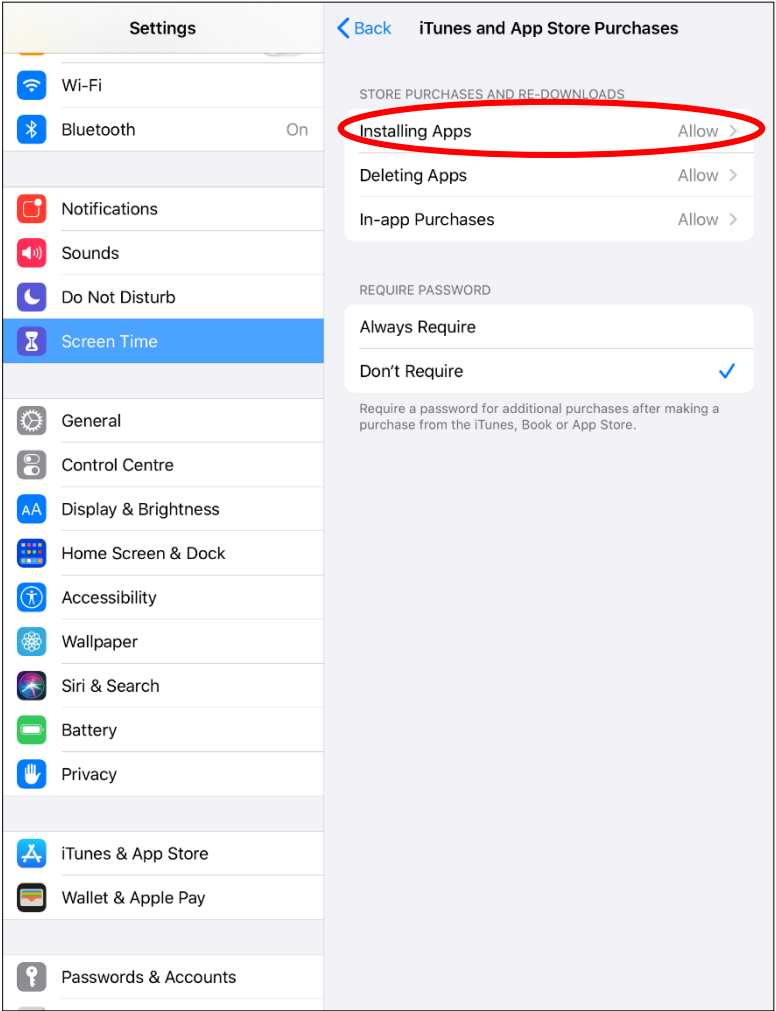
... go to 'Screen Time' and tap on 'Content & Privacy Restrictions'



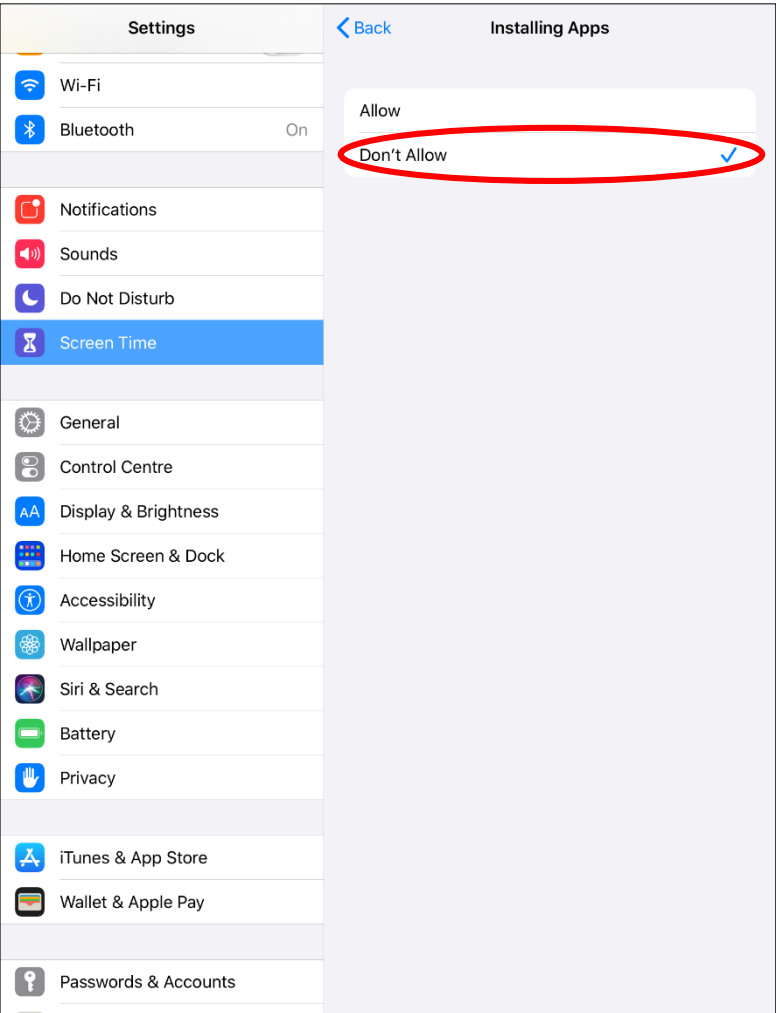
Tap on 'iTunes and App Store Purchases' and enter your passcode



Tap on 'Installing Apps'



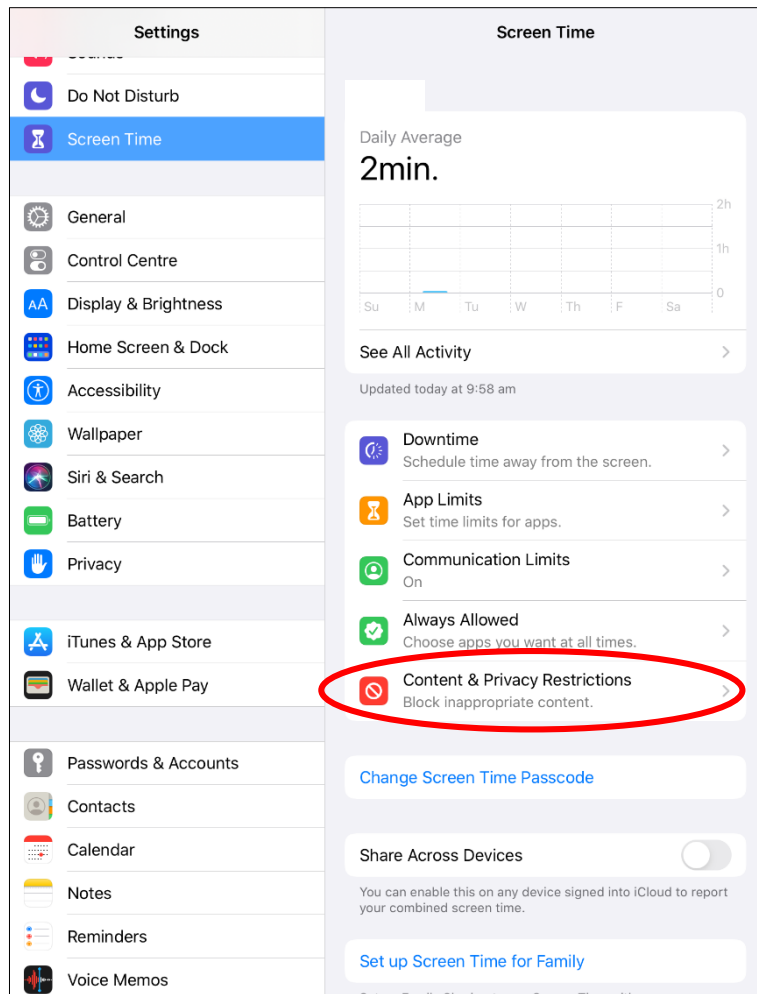
Then tap on 'Don't Allow'



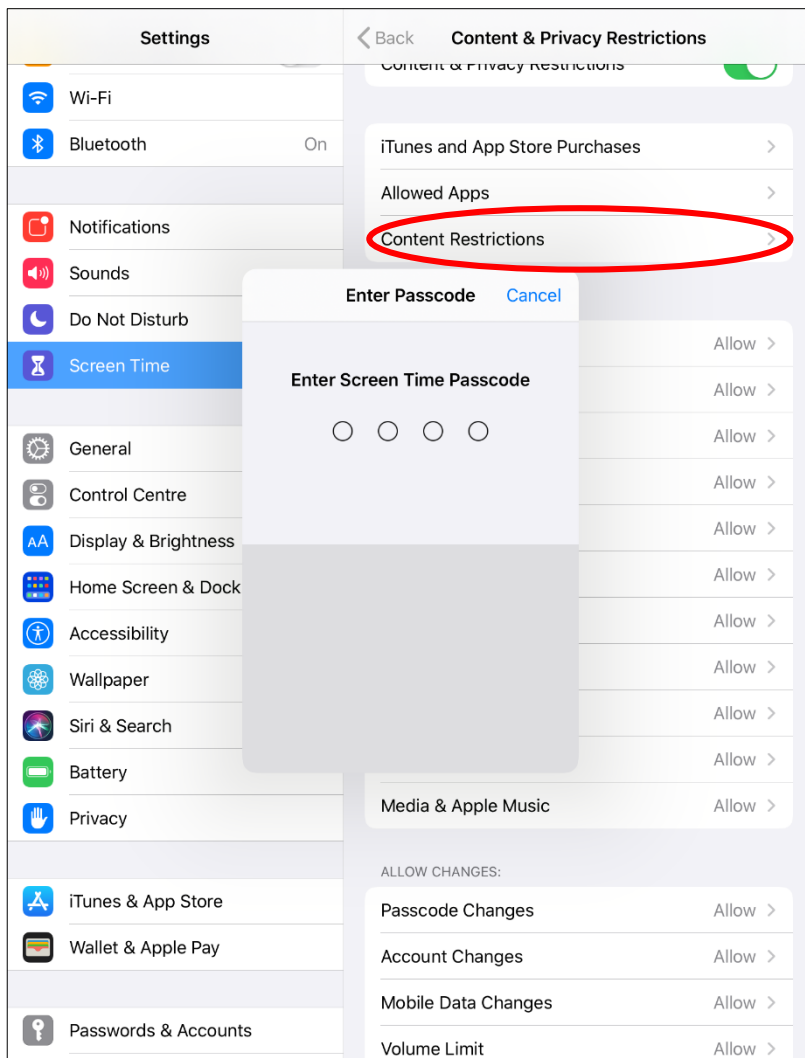
Your child now won't be able to download new apps anymore since the App Store will have disappeared from the Home Screen

To restrict adult content
on your child's iPad...

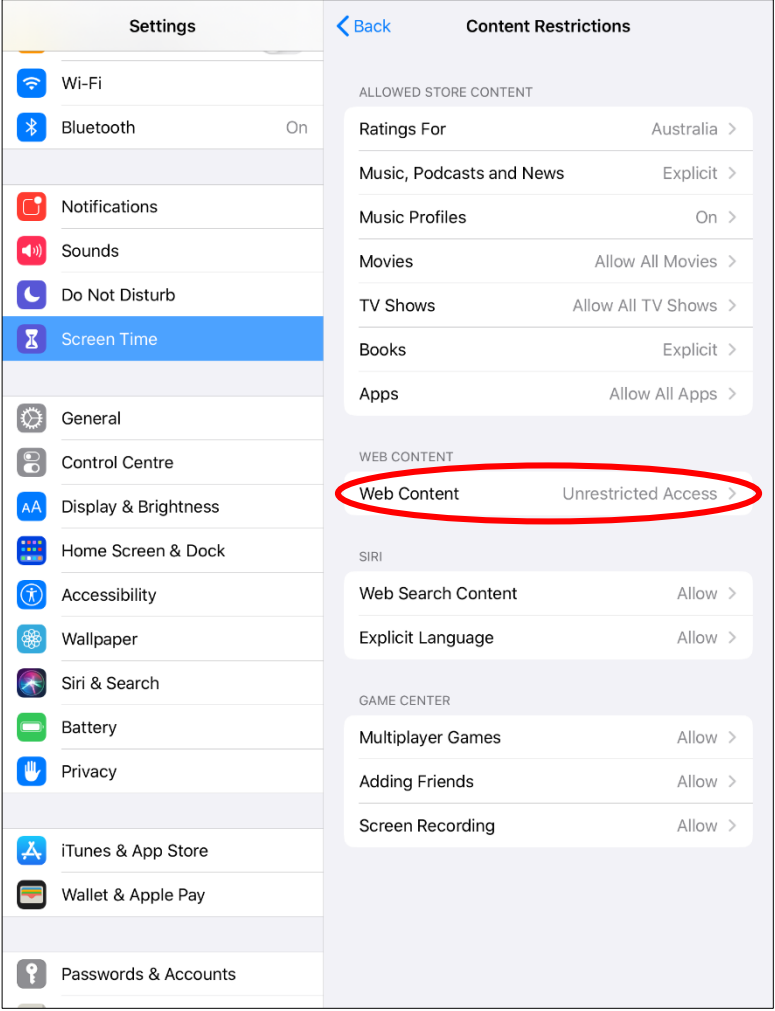
... go to 'Screen Time' and
tap on 'Content & Privacy
Restrictions'



Tap on 'Content
Restrictions' and enter
your passcode



Tap on **‘Web Content’**



Then tap on **‘Limit Adult Websites’**
